Description

Front: Cista mystica mit Schlange umgeben von einer Efeugirlande. Oben eingeritzt ein Kappa.

Rear: Zwei sich aufrichtende Schlangen, zwischen ihnen ein Köcher, l. Monogramm aus Π, P und E (für Pergamon), oben ΦΙ, darunter Monogramm aus ΠΡΥ (für prytaneis). Im r. F. von Schlange umwundener Thyrsosstab. Überprägt.

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.

Overstruck: A coin or medal used as a flan to produce a new coin and that has been struck with a new die.
