## Description

Front: Zwei Ringer, der l. packt mit seiner r. Hand das l. Handgelenk seines Gegners und boxt ihn mit seiner l. Faust in den Unterleib.

Rear: Schleuderer in weiter Schrittstellung nach r., r. Triskeles. Sieben unterschiedliche Gegenstempel mit verschiedenen Bildmotiven.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
