Description

Front: Drapierte Büste der Annia Faustina in der Brustansicht nach r. Im r. F. runder Gegenstempel mit dem Wertzeichen E (= 5 assaria/asses).

Rear: Sechssäulige Tempelfront, darin die Statue des Apollon Sidetes nach l.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
