Description

Front: Kopf des C. Iulius Caesar (Octavianus) mit Bart nach r. Punze P auf dem Kopf, eine weitere darunter.

Rear: Schöpfkelle (simpulum), Weihwedel (aspergillum), Krug (sitella) und Krummstab (lituus).

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
