## Description

Front: Drapierte Büste der Otacilia Severa in der Brustansicht nach r.

Rear: Pudicitia sitzt nach l. und hebt mit der r. Hand ihrer Schleier an. In der l. Hand hält sie ein Zepter.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
