Description

Front: Kopf des C. Iulius Caesar (Octavianus) nach l. Punzen auf Wange und Schläfe.

Rear: Victoria steht auf einem Globus nach r. Sie hält in der r. Hand einen Kranz und in der l. Hand einen Palmzweig.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
