## Description

Front: Panzerbüste des Traianus Decius mit Strahlenkrone in der Brustansicht nach r., die l. Schulter ist drapiert.

Rear: Felicitas steht nach l. Im r. Arm ein Merkurstab (caduceus), im l. Arm ein Füllhorn. Beiderseits S - C.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
