## Description

Front: Kopf des bartlosen Pan mit Efeukranz nach l. Darunter ein Gegenstempel Bogen in Bogentasche über dem älteren Untertyp Löwenkopf mit [II-]A-N.

Rear: Bogen über Pfeil nach r. Darunter ein Gegenstempel zwölfstrahliger Stern über dem älteren Untertyp Panskopf.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.

Overstruck: A coin or medal used as a flan to produce a new coin and that has been struck with a new die.
