## Description

Front: Der geflügelte Riese Talos in der Vorderansicht, in beiden Händen einen Stein haltend. Unten r. ein runder Gegenstempel.

Rear: Stier mit eingeknicktem Vorderhuf und gesenktem, nach vorn gedrehtem Kopf nach r.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
