Description

Front: Halbiertes 8-Realesstück mit vier rechteckigen Gegenstempel. Kopf des Karl IV. mit Lorbeerkranz nach rechts.

Rear: Bekrönter spanischer Wappenschild.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.

Bisected: The result of intentional division into roughly equal halves.
