## Description

Front: Kopf der Artemis Parthenos mit Lorbeerkranz nach r., an der Schulter Bogen und Köcher. Im l. F. ein kreisförmiger Gegenstempel mit Delphin.

Rear: Stier nach l., darunter HPΩ[ΙΔΑ].

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
