## Description

Front: Kopf des C. Iulius Caesar (Octavianus) mit Bart nach r. Im Nacken eine Punze.

Rear: Viersäuliger Tempel des vergöttlichten Gaius Iulius Caesar, darin eine verschleierte Gestalt mit Krummstab (lituus). Auf dem Architrav DIVO IVL, im Giebel ein Stern. Neben dem Tempel l. ein entzündeter Altar.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
