## Description

Front: Kopf des bartlosen Mars mit Helm nach r. Im r. F. drei Punzen.

Rear: Außenseite eines Rundschildes, dessen Zentrum mit einem achtstrahligen Stern (sidus Veneris oder sidus Iulium) geschmückt ist. Dahinter Speer und Schwert über Kreuz.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
