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Description

Front: Kopf der Artemis mit Bogen und Köcher an der Schulter nach r.

Rear: Hund nach r., darüber eine Fackel. Zwischen Hund und Fackel ein Gegenstempel bzw. vertieftes Feld mit zwei eingeritzten Sternen.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
