## Description

Front: Geöffnete Hand nach l. ausgestreckt. Mehrere Prüfhiebe.

Rear: Victoria steht mit wehendem Gewand auf einem Globus nach r. Sie hält in der r. Hand einen Kranz und in der l. Hand einen geschulterten Palmzweig.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
