Description

Front: Kopf des Augustus nach r. Auf der Wange eine Punze C.

Rear: Eichenkranz (corona civica), darin Schriftfeld in drei Zeilen.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
