Description

Front: Kopf des C. Iulius Caesar (Octavianus) nach r. Im r. F. mehrere C-förmige Punzen.
Rear: Triumphbogen, darauf Viergespann (quadriga) mit C. Iulius Caesar (Octavianus) in der Vorderansicht.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
