Description

Front: Kopf des Augustus nach r.

Rear: Androkephaler Stier nach r., zum Betrachter blickend. Über ihm fliegt eine Victoria nach r., in der r. Hand ein Kranz, mit der l. Hand das r. Ohr des Mannstiers berührend.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
