Description

Front: Kopf des Augustus nach r. Am Hals ein rechteckiger Gegenstempel IMP VES (IMP V ligiert).

Rear: Ein Krieger mit Rundschild steht in der Vorderansicht, den barhäuptigen Kopf nach r., über einer nach l. hingesunkenen weiblichen Gestalt, der er unter den l. Arm greift.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
