Description

Front: Kopf des Augustus nach r. Im l. F. auf Hals und Kopf zwei Punzen und mehrere Einhiebe.

Rear: Victoria steht auf einem Schiffsbug (prora) nach l. In der r. Hand ein Kranz, im l. Arm ein geschulterter Palmzweig.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
