Front: Toga picta mit Tunica palmata zwischen Adlerzepter l. und Kranz r.

Rear: Viergespann (quadriga) nach r. Darüber r. vier kleine Pferde nach r.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.

Part(s) broken away: Sections of the coin or medal are broken away (without any traces of mechanic manipulation).
