## Description

Front: Kopf des Mars nach r. Punze auf dem Hals.

Rear: Pegasus steht mit erhobenem l. Vorderhuf nach r.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
