Description

Front: Kopf des Augustus nach r. Am Hals eine Punze Γ (retrograd).

Rear: Priesterkappe (apex) zwischen zwei ovalen Schilden (ancilia).

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
