Description

Front: Büste des Caracalla mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Hermes steht der in Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l. In seiner r. Hand hält er eine Geldbörse und in der l. Hand einen Heroldstab (kerykeion).

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
