## Description

Front: Dreizeilige Aufschrift in Eichenkranz (corona civica). Darunter ein runder Gegenstempel mit Zweig.

Rear: Großformatiges S C umgeben von der Umschrift. Im r. F. ein runder Gegenstempel mit Capricorn unter Stern.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
