## Description

Front: Der Heilige Markus (?) reicht den vor ihm knienden Dorino Gattilusio die Fahne.

Rear: Christus umgeben von Sternen in einer Mandorla stehend.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
