## Description

Front: Kopf des Nero Claudius Drusus nach l. Im r. F. ein rechteckiger Gegenstempel NCAPR.

Rear: Claudius sitzt in der Toga nach l. gewandt auf einem Amtsstuhl (sella curulis). Er hält in der r. Hand einen Lorbeerzweig, auf dem Boden liegen verschiedene Gegenstände der militärischen Ausrüstung.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
