Description

Front: Kopf des Augustus mit Lorbeerkranz nach r. Am Hals Punze S.

Rear: Gaius Caesar galoppiert nach r. Er hält in der r. Hand die Zügel und in der l. Hand einen Schild sowie ein Schwert (?), um seinen Hals ein Anhänger (bullae). Hinten l. ein Legionsadler (aquila) zwischen zwei Feldzeichen.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
