Description

Front: Löwenkopf mit fünfstrahliger Warze nach r. Punze.

Rear: Zwei quadratische Incusa mit unregelmäßiger Binnenstruktur nebeneinander.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
