Description

Front: Kopf des Asklepios mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Sich aufrichtende eingerollte Schlange nach r., darum Aufschrift mit Magistratsnamen und Ethnikon. Das Ganze in quadratum incusum.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
