## Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste mit Diadem nach rechts.

Rear: Engel mit einem Kreuzglobus in der linken und einem Kranz in der rechten Hand. Im r. F. ein Stern.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
