Description

Front: Amtsstuhl (sella curulis), an welchem r. ein Zepter lehnt. Darüber ein ovaler Gegenstempel mit Kopf nach l.

Rear: Liktorenbeil (fasces) und Capricorn mit Globus zwischen den Vorderbeinen nach r.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
