## Description

Front: Kopf des Tiberius mit Lorbeerkranz nach r. Im r. F. eine Punze.

Rear: Tiberius steht in einem nach r. fahrenden Viergespann (quadriga). Er hält in der r. Hand einen Lorbeerzweig und in der l. Hand ein Adlerzepter.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
