Description

Front: Kopf des Marcus Antonius mit Bart nach r. Mehrere Punzen.

Rear: Zweisäuliger Tempel, darin ein Medaillon mit dem Kopf des Sol mit Strahlenkranz in der Vorderansicht.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
