Description

Front: Kopf des Marcus Antonius mit Bart nach r. Dahinter ein Krummstab (lituus). Im r. F. Graffito A, im l. F. ein tiefer Kratzer.

Rear: Kopf des Sol mit Strahlenkranz nach r.

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.
