Description

Front: Bärtiger Kopf des Marcus Antonius nach r. Dahinter ein Krummstab (lituus).

Rear: Bekränzter Kopf des Gaius Iulius Caesar nach r., dahinter eine Kanne (sitella).

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.
