## Description

Front: Lilienkreuz im Vierpass, in den Winkeln C-R-V-X. Gegenstempel Rose, halber Stern, Balkenschild, Rad mit Kugeln zwischen den Speichen.

Rear: Meißnischer Löwe nach links. Gegenstempel zweimal Rose.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
