Description

Front: Kriegsschiff (Galeere) nach r., hinter dem Schiffsbug mit Bändern geschmückter Dolonmast. Oben zwei Punzen.

Rear: Legionsadler (aquila) zwischen zwei Feldzeichen (signa).

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
