Description

Front: Krummstab (lituus), Kanne (sitella) und Rabe nach I. Unten zwei Punzen S und C.
Rear: Schöpfkelle (simpulum), Weihwedel (aspergillum), Axt (securis) und Priesterhut (apex).
Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
