## Description

Front: Lilienkreuz im Vierpass, in den Winkeln C-R-V-X. Gegenstempel halber Stern und zweimal Schild (geteilt, oben Kreuz, unten Pfähle).

Rear: Meißnischer Löwe nach links. Gegenstempel zweimal sechsspeichiges Rad.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
