Description

Front: Bekränzter Kopf des Gaius Iulius Caesar nach r. Auf der Wange eine Punze.

Rear: Venus thront nach r. Sie hält in der r. Hand eine Victoria und in der l. Hand ein Zepter.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
