Front: Panzerbüste des Decentius in der Brustansicht nach r.

Rear: Zwei Victorien halten zwischen sich einen von einem Christogramm gekrönten Kranz, darin die vierzeilige Aufschrift VOT / V / MVLT / X. Darunter SP.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
