Description

Front: Bekränzter Kopf des Gaius Iulius Caesar nach r. Im l. F. Punze V.

Rear: Füllhorn (cornucopiae) auf Globus, l. ein Steuerruder, r. ein geflügelter Merkurstab (caduceus) und ein Priesterhut (apex).

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
