Description

Front: Kopf des Apollon mit kurzem Haar und Lorbeerkranz nach r. Darum herum in kyprischen Buchstaben (ba-si-le-o-se Sa-ta-si-o-i-ko).

Rear: Eine Göttin (Aphrodite) reitet auf einem Stier nach r. Darüber und darunter in kyprischen Buchstaben (ba-si-le-o-se Sa-ta-si-o-i-ko). Das Ganze in quadratum incusum.

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
