## Description

Front: Kopf des Vespasianus mit Lorbeerkranz nach r. Darauf eine Kerbe.

Rear: Iupiter steht in Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l. Er hält in der ausgestreckten r. Hand eine Schale (patera) über einen Altar und im l. Arm ein Zepter. Im l. F. ein Graffito.

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
