Front: Unbärtiger Doppelkopf mit Kappe (petasos). Oben gelocht.

Rear: Wertzeichen I.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
