Description

Front: Gekrönte verschlungene Initiale FR. Darunter Münzstättenzeichen A. Im l. F. eine Punze.

Rear: Unten Jahreszahl 1772, Wertzahl zwischen zwei Sternen.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
