## Description

Front: Büste des Innocenz XI. mit Kappe (camauro) und verzierter Stola, darauf ein Pflanzenornament, nach rechts. Unten die Signatur HAMERANVS F. Oben links über dem Ohr eine Punze.

Rear: Fünfzeilige Aufschrift in Palmkranz.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
