## Description

Front: Büste Sigismund III. im Harnisch mit Krone und Halskrause, Schwert in der rechten Hand und Reichsapfel in der linken Hand. Im r. F. in Tusche 364.

Rear: Bekrönter Wappenschild Adler (Polen), Reiter (Litauen), umhangen mit Kollane des Ordens vom Goldenen Vlies, darauf Schild Kronen (Schweden), Löwe (Gotland), darauf Herzschild Garbe (Wasa). Aussen 16-29, II-VE, 3-0, Wappenschild Kronschatzmeister.

Gilded: With an overlay (wholly or in parts) of a thin layer of gold. Process is not part of the regular production.

Inscribed upon (by hand): An object has been inscribed by hand with ink etc.

Recut die: Secondary re-engraving of a die after it has already been used to strike coins, medals, or tokens, e.g. to repair defects in the die or modify its design.
