Front: Kopf des Otho nach r.

Rear: Victoria steht auf einem Globus nach l. In ihrer l. Hand hält sie einen Palmzweig und in der vorgestreckten r. Hand einen Kranz.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
